Los Abogados 2021 Pipeline LSAT Fellowship Application.

Los Abogados invites individuals who plan to take the Fall2021 LSAT to apply for the Los Abogados Pipeline LSAT Fellowship.

<u>Fellowship Scholarship Award</u>: Tuition paid Kaplan LSAT Preparation Program; weekly practice LSAT practice exams proctored by members of the Los Abogados organization; a personal assigned mentor to each Fellow; one individual meeting with an admissions counselor from the Admissions Department of University of Arizona and Arizona State University.

Application Qualifications and Requirements:

- Applicants must meet the eligibility requirements to take the Fall 2021 LSAT https://www.lsac.org/applying-law-school/jd-application-process/jd-application-requirements;
- Provide a Personal Statement that demonstrates their experience and skills in leadership, service to the community, and support efforts in the Hispanic/Latino community;
- Submit Completed Application
- Submit a Resume:
- Submit Undergraduate Transcripts (unofficial copies acceptable)
- Demonstrate Financial need.

Applicants must submit their completed application by Monday, April 5, 2021.

Fellows Responsibilities: Fellow recipients will be expected to complete homework as

assigned by the instructor and adhere to the Attendance Policy. During the sessions, Los Abogados will also be offering information concerning the law school admissions process, including, but not limited to, financial aid considerations and best practices for resumes, personal statements, and applications.
